• • • WIC PROGRAM 888-5455

W.I.C. provides nutrition and health services to pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants and children under 5 years who meet nutritional and financial guidelines. Eligible recipients receive a supplemental food package each month. Appointments are required for certification and clinic services. This institution is an equal opportunity provider.

• • • FAMILY CASE MANAGEMENT 888-5517, 888-5462, 1-800-474-0800

Case management services are provided for pregnant women, infants and children up to age 2. The program assists families in maintaining mental and physical wellness. Prenatal care services are available for pregnant clients eligible for WIC or AllKids.

• • • TEEN PARENT SERVICES 888-5517, 888-5462, 1-800-474-0800

Provides case management services to pregnant and parenting teens 19 years of age and younger who are enrolled in high school or GED classes.

• • • PREVENTIVE CARE FOR CHILDREN 888-5479

Preventive health services, including immunizations and laboratory tests, are provided for children 0-5 years whose families meet financial eligibility requirements. Appointments are required.

• • • IMMUNIZATIONS 888-5455

Appointments are available Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday 8:15-11:30 a.m. and 1:00-3:30 pm., the 3rd Monday of the month 2:30-6:00 p.m., and one Saturday morning a month. Appointments are required. Clients must meet income eligibility guidelines; current IPA/All Kids cards are accepted.

• • • DENTAL CLINIC 888-5479

Exams and treatments including preventive and restorative care are available to children. Adult care is limited to pain control measures. All clients must meet financial eligibility guidelines. Current IPA/All Kids cards are accepted. Appointments are required.

• • • EYE CARE PROGRAM 888-5468

Eye care services are arranged with local providers and include exams and eye glasses. A \$40.00/adult and \$10.00/child co-pay is charged for each pair of eye glasses. Clients must meet financial eligibility guidelines. Appointments are required. This program is managed jointly with the John M. Scott Health Resources Center.

• • • HOME NURSING 888-5468

Public Health Nurses provide in-home physical assessments and nursing care for adults as ordered by a physician. Eligibility is based on needs.

• • • STD CLINIC 888-5457

Provides confidential testing, treatment and follow-up for: gonorrhea, syphilis and chlamydia. For women, additional testing is performed for trichomonas, bacterial vaginosis and yeast. Hepatitis prevention measures are also available. No residency requirement. A \$10.00 basic fee is charged and other fees may be charged based upon client's ability to pay. Appointments are available. Walk-ins are accepted on Tuesday afternoons.

• • • HIV COUNSELING AND TESTING 888-5435

Provides anonymous and confidential HIV counseling and testing services. Appointments are available. Walk-ins are accepted on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. While no fee is charged, donations are accepted to help provide services.

• • • TUBERCULOSIS (TB) CLINIC 888-5435

TB skin tests, diagnostic testing and medical consultation and treatment are provided. All TB services are by appointment only.

• • • INTERPRETIVE SERVICES

Interpretive services are provided at no cost to clients during their visits.
