Dear John:

The Town of Normal Parks and Recreation Department has an exciting new renovation project at Fairview Park that is scheduled to begin the design process in the next 30 days. As a part of the improvements at Fairview Park we will be removing the 24 year old waterslide and its support components such as the basin and the mechanical building.

The firm we have selected for the design is Williams Aquatics of Carol Stream, IL who will be coordinating with a local architectural firm, Shive-Hattery, for the civil engineering of the project.

This project is anticipated to begin the design process in the next thirty days, followed by permitting, bid letting, award of contract and then complete construction in time to re-open the facility to the public for the 2009 season. We will not begin demolition until after Labor Day of 2008, so no interruption in service is anticipated.

As I am sure you are aware, the Town, as a part of our lease agreement, must notify the County of any capital improvements on the site.
