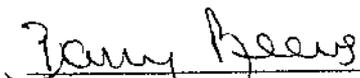

WEIGHT LIMIT AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into this day by and between Barry Reeves, 19083 Meander Way, Bloomington, IL 61704, and McLean County hereby provides for the following:

1. Barry Reeves will pay for one-half (1/2) of the cost of increasing the weight limit on the Towanda-Gridley Road, County Highway 29, from the Interstate 55 Interchange north approximately 2,150 feet to the Reeves' Farm north entrance, from 73,280 pounds to 80,000 pounds for semi trailer loads. The total estimated cost of this work is based on 350 tons of bituminous hot mix binder course at forty-two dollars (\$42.00) per ton for a total of fourteen thousand, seven hundred dollars (\$14,700.00). Barry Reeves' estimated share of the cost for his one half (1/2) of this is Seven-thousand, three hundred fifty dollars (\$7,350.00). The actual amount owed by Barry Reeves to the McLean County Highway Department shall be for 175 tons of bituminous hot mix binder course at the bid price on McLean County Section 03-00071-02-WR.
2. McLean County hereby agrees to designate the Towanda-Gridley Road, County Highway 29, from the Interstate 55 Interchange north approximately 2,150 feet to the Reeve's Farm North Entrance as an 80,000 pound Class III Truck route upon completion of the resurfacing project, Section 03-00071-02-WR and signed accordingly.
3. Payment by Barry Reeves of Seven-thousand, three hundred fifty dollars (\$7,350.00) is due upon his signing of the Agreement. The final amount owed or to be returned by the County shall be due when the bid price is known and the project, Towanda-Gridley Road, County Highway 29, Section 03-00071-02-WR is awarded.
4. McLean County Highway Department shall pay for the balance of the cost of the project.
5. It is mutually agreed that this Agreement shall be null and void should the resurfacing of the Towanda-Gridley Road from the Interstate 55 Interchange north to the Reeves' Farm North Entrance not be completed within three (3) years after the date of this Agreement.

On 03/10/00, I was dispatched to 1500N and 3400E to investigate a bridge located there that had been damaged by fire as a result of a controlled burn on farmland there.

Upon arrival, I spoke with Richard Brettnacher and Kieth Frantz, both McLean County Highway Department workers who discovered the damage at 9:00am on 03/10/00. I saw that the farmland to the south and east of the bridge, along a creek that runs under the bridge, had been burned off. The bridge had sustained damage as a result of the fire. Two poles that held up the guardrail had been completely burned away, providing no support to the rail. Smoke was still rising from the poles. Wooden planking under and to the east of the bridge had been burned away as well. These planks provide support for the road that leads up to the bridge. I could see that the dirt and rock fill that is contained by the planking was beginning to erode away and fall into the creek. As a result of the damage, the bridge was declared not suitable for use and the highway department closed road 1500N between 3400E and 3500E.

The highway department took photographs of the damage on their digital camera. I obtained the disk that the pictures were on and made copy of that disk. I then called Rick Vance, Martin Township road commissioner, and asked him if he knew whom the land that was burned belonged to. He said Larry Durbin farmed the land where the burn was. I contacted Larry on 03/11/00. Larry said he did not know who burned the land around the bridge. He did not discover the land had been burned until the afternoon of 03/10/00. Larry said that Danny Wilson farmed the land east of his and may know something more. I have not been able to make contact with Wilson.

This report is pending until I can make contact with the person who started the controlled burn.

Supplemental Reporting DEPUTY SHERIFF JASON SIMMONS - MCSP, ID # 9487

On 03/17/00, I spoke with several residents of the area where the fire occurred.

Donald Wilson, who lives directly east of the damaged bridge, said that he did not know who farmed the land or who started the fire. His wife, Marilyn, said that the fire was quite large with a lot of smoke. Donald said that the fire started from the south and the wind carried it up the creek.

Leonard Sandage, who lives on 3500E, first house north of Rt. 9, said that he knew Barry Reeves farmed the land in the area, but did not know who set the fire or when it started.

I started towards a residence on Rt. 9 in between 3400E and 3500E. Approximately halfway in between, there is a bridge that crosses a small creek, which runs to the damaged bridge. I noticed that a controlled burn had been started there.

Dan Kerber, who lives on Rt. 9 one-eighth mile west of the origin of the fire, said Barry Reeves farms the land the fire occurred on. Dan did not know who set the fire or when it started.

I returned to the bridge on Rt. 9. I saw that the trail of burned grassland followed the creek bed to the northwest. I went north on 3400E and saw the creek bed led up to the damaged bridge, with burned grassland along the length of the creek. The burned areas stopped at, but included, the bridge.

At this point, I am awaiting contact with Barry Reeves.

On 03/20/00, I spoke with Barry Reeves. Barry said that he sent his son and two employees out to burn the ditch starting at Rt. 9 one-half mile east of 3400E. He told them to watch the fire and ensure that it did not spread to other people's property. They put the fire out at Reeves' property line. Barry went out to inspect the work sometime later and noticed that a ditch that runs from the main creek west to 3400E had not been burned. Barry sent two employees, Justin Gibbs and Josh Nyberg, out to burn the ditch. He told them to watch it and ensure that it did not burn other's property. Barry was not aware that the bridge had been damaged.

I spoke with Justin Gibbs. He said that he and Josh went out to the ditch before lunchtime on 03/09/00 to burn a ditch north of Rt. 9 on the dirt road (3400E is a dirt road north of Rt. 9) that had not burned on the initial controlled burn. They lit the ditch and watched it from the dirt road. After a period of time, they felt that the fire was out as there was no more smoke, so they left. They did not leave the roadway to check that the fire was out. Justin was not aware that the bridge had been damaged until 03/20/00 when Barry called him to inform him of it.

I spoke with Josh Nyberg. His account of the incident concurred with Justin's account. Josh added that after they lit the fire at the ditch, it was not taking off very well. They went to start another burn on a fencerow. They returned to the ditch and saw that it did not appear to be taking off, so they left. Josh was not aware that the bridge had been damaged until 03/20/00.

All investigative leads had been contacted in this case. I recommend that this case be administratively closed due to the fact that there was no criminal intent and it is a civil matter.

Old Town Road District, McLean County, Illinois requests that McLean County in accordance with the Illinois Highway Code, 605 ILCS 5/5-501, of the current Illinois Compiled Statutes as amended; construct one drainage structure with approach fills located on the East line of the SE ¼ of Section 29, T23N, R3E of the 3rd P.M., in Old Town Road District.

That of the funds appropriated at the November 2003 meeting of the McLean County Board, Ninety Six Thousand Dollars (\$96,000.00) be used as the County's share of the cost of the structure and approach work.

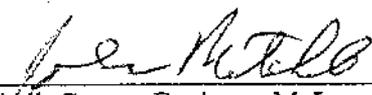
Old Town Road District certifies that they have levied the maximum on their Road and Bridge Fund the last two years.

Old Town Road District further states that the County Engineer has made a survey of the water shed and has determined that the site of the new drainage structure shall be as mentioned above and has estimated that the cost of the new drainage structure shall be Three Hundred Nine Thousand Dollars (\$309,000.00) total, with the cost divided between Old Town Road District at One Hundred Four Thousand Dollars (\$104,000.00), McLean County at Ninety Six Thousand Dollars (\$96,000.00), and Larry Bielfeldt, developer of Sherwood Lakes Subdivision at One Hundred Nine Thousand Dollars (\$109,000.00) and that the existing structure is inadequate.

Old Town Road District further certifies that the cost of the new structure exceeds 0.02% of the assessed valuation of the Road District.

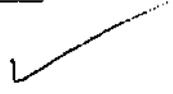

Please find attached two copies of our standard Project Agreement form and Schedule of Hourly Rates and Expenses that are intended to represent the basis of a contract arrangement by and between Lewis, Yockey & Brown, Inc. (Consultant) and McLean County Highway Department (Department) for Consultant to provide land surveying and platting services to Department as may be requested for various projects under the Department's jurisdiction.

Services that may be provided are limited to land surveying services and applications of surveying that Department may require from time to time to facilitate the design or construction of highway improvements in McLean County.

Examples of services currently being provided to McLean County Highway Department on a "demand" basis are listed as follows:

1. Land surveying for highway right of way and easement acquisition associated with highway maintenance and new construction.
2. Right of way records research associated with highway projects.
3. Topographical surveying locating existing physical improvements and elevations as basis for road improvement design.
4. Land section corner preservation and monumentation where road maintenance (resurfacing) or new construction would destroy existing survey monuments.
5. Vertical and horizontal control survey work using Global Positioning System (GPS) survey technology.

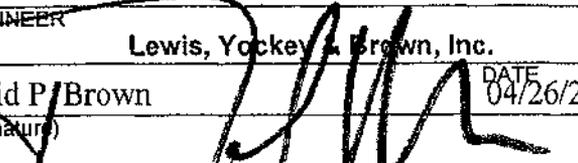

**PROJECT AGREEMENT
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

To assure an understanding of matters related to our mutual responsibilities, these terms and conditions for professional engineering and surveying are made a part of this agreement for our services:

AMENDMENTS

This agreement may be amended in writing providing both the client and Engineer agree to such modifications.

COMPENSATION FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

The basis for compensation will be as identified in the agreement.

For the purpose of this "Agreement" the word "Expenses" or "Reimbursable Expenses" shall mean all direct or indirect costs incurred in connection with the Engineer's performance of the work as may be posted on the Engineer's schedule of Hourly Rates for Employee classifications and Expenses Rates, including but not limited to the following: Transportation and subsistence, toll telephone calls, telegrams, reproductions or printing, survey supplies, drafting supplies, computer time, environmental equipment, and the services of outside consultants plus a maximum markup of 15% of the outside consultant's fees.

When "Hourly Rates and Expenses" is utilized, the schedule of Hourly Rates for Employee classifications and Expense Rates of the Engineer shall be the basis for the Fee for services. If an "estimate" is indicated, the fee will be payed upon the time and materials expended, and unusual problems or difficulties may necessitate the fee to exceed the "estimate."

When "Lump Sum" payment is utilized it shall include all labor and may not include expenses (for the scope of work as defined in the agreement) incurred by Engineer and shall not exceed the fixed payment amount without prior authorization of the client.

When "Payroll Costs" payment is utilized it shall be computed by a multiplier factor times payroll cost plus expenses.

The "Payroll Costs" means the salaries and wages paid to all Engineering personnel engaged directly on the work plus the cost of customary and statutory benefits including social security contributions, unemployment, health, sick leave, vacation, workmans compensation, incentive and holiday pay applicable thereto.

The "Multiplier" is a factor for general direct overhead, indirect costs, profit and other costs. The Multiplier factor rate shall be identified in the agreement.

TIME OF PAYMENT

The Engineer may submit monthly statements for services and expenses based upon the proportion of the actual work completed at the time of billing. Unless provided for otherwise, payments for engineering services will be due and payable thirty (30) calendar days from the issuance of the Engineer's statement.

LATE PAYMENT

If the client fails to make any payment due the Engineer for services and expenses within the time period specified, a service charge of 1 1/2% per month will be added to the Client's account. This is an annual rate of 18%.

LEGAL EXPENSE

The client agrees to pay all costs and expenses, including court costs and reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Engineer in any action or proceeding brought to enforce any provision of this agreement including, without limitation, the collection of all fees incurred hereunder, and further agrees that such costs and fees may be included in and form a part of any Judgement entered in any proceeding brought by the Engineer, or his firm, against the client.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The client agrees to limit the Engineer's liability to the client and to all construction contractors and subcontractors where applicable, on this work, for damages to them, due to the Engineer's negligent acts, errors or omissions, such that the total aggregate liability of the Engineer to all named shall not exceed \$50,000 or the Engineer's total fee for services rendered on this work, whichever is greater.

AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITY

The Engineer shall not guarantee the quality or quantity of the work of any Contractor or Subcontractor, shall have no authority to stop work, shall have no supervision or control as to the work or persons doing the work, shall not have charge of the work, shall not be responsible for safety in, on, or about the job site or have any control of the safety or adequacy of any equipment, building component, scaffolding, supports, forms or other work aids, and shall have no duties or responsibilities imposed by the Structural Work Act.

TERMINATION

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon notice. Any termination shall only be for good causes such as for legal considerations, unavailability of adequate financing on either the Client or Engineers part, or major changes in the work. In the event of any termination, the Engineer will be paid for all services and expenses rendered to the date of termination on a basis of Standard Hourly Rates plus reimbursable expenses, plus reasonable termination costs.

REUSE OF DOCUMENTS

All documents including drawings and specifications furnished by the Engineer pursuant to this Agreement are instruments of his services in respect to the work. They are not intended or represented to be suitable for reuse by client or others on extensions of this work, or on any other work. Any reuse without specific written verification or adaption by the Engineer will be at the Client's sole risk, and without liability of the Engineer, and the Client shall indemnify and hold harmless the Engineer from all claims, damages, losses and expenses including attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting therefrom. Any such verification or adaption will entitle the Engineer to further compensation at rates to be agreed upon by the Client and Engineer.

ESTIMATES OF COST

Since the Engineer has no control over the cost of labor, materials or equipment or over a Contractor(s) method of determining prices, or over competitive bidding or market conditions, his opinions, of probable Project Cost or Construction Cost that may be provided for herein are to be made on the basis of his experience and qualifications and represent his best judgement as a design professional familiar with the construction industry, but the Engineer cannot and does not guarantee that proposals, bids or the construction cost will not vary from opinions of probable cost prepared by him. If the client wishes greater assurance as to the Construction Cost, he shall employ an independent cost estimator.

RE: Diesel Fuel and Bio-Diesel Fuel

Last fall we reported to you (copy attached) that the trial of Bio-Diesel fuel worked well and that there were no adverse problems and there was no noticeable change in power either. However, last year FS waived the 2 cents per gallon charge for Bio-Diesel. Now this year we have been told that FS will want 3 cents per gallon for Bio-Diesel. On top of that we have had another Bidder bidding Diesel fuel approximately 5 cents a gallon cheaper than FS. This Bidder does not have Bio-Diesel fuel. So now our cost will no longer be 2 cents a gallon more for Bio-Diesel, but it would be approximately 8 cent a gallon depending upon the quotes on the day we took them.

Last year we used 64,400 gallons of Bio-Diesel and Diesel fuel which at 8 cents per gallon would cost us \$5,152.00 to use all Bio-Diesel. In the past, we have always gone with the low bid for fuel. We think that we should continue to do that, but it will probably mean that we will no longer be able to use Bio-Diesel.

McLean County Highway Department BioDiesel Fuel Study Results

I am providing information to the board at this time regarding our study on the use of BioDiesel in McLean County Highway Department vehicles.

I have used two tanker loads, the first delivered on July 23, 2003, totaling 9200 gallons, and the second delivery on the date of September 9, 2003, totaling 7500 gallons of Biodiesel. In all total we have used over 16,700 gallons of Biodiesel with no noticeable side effects. Fuel economy has not changed and there have not been any noticeable changes in power from the equipment. Our current service trends have not been altered in anyway. I am getting ready for winter and replacing the BioDiesel with regular diesel fuel for wintertime use. I feel that the use of BioDiesel for summertime use may be a very good decision in helping to provide our community with a cleaner environment with few if any side effects.
