

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Transportation Committee

The Land Use and Development Committee of the McLean County Board met on Tuesday, March 15, 2005 at 8:50 a.m. in Room 400 of the Government Center, 115 East Washington Street, Bloomington, Illinois.

Chairman Bass presented the bills from October, 2005, which have been reviewed and recommended for transmittal to the Land Use and Development Committee by the County Auditor. Chairman Gordon stated that the prepaid total and the fund total is \$655,109.56 with the prepaid total being the same.

Mr. Mitchell informed the Committee that he received a call from an engineer at the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) in Paris, IL. IDOT has proposed a Jurisdictional Transfer of the Lexington and Towanda overpasses to McLean County. IDOT has agreed to patch and resurface the overpasses if McLean County agrees to pledge the \$800,000.00 in federal grant funds toward the project. Mr. Mitchell asked the Committee if this proposal is one that would be acceptable with them. The Committee agreed that this proposal would be in both IDOT's and McLean County's best interest.

Chairman Bass asked if there were any other questions. Hearing none, he adjourned the meeting at 8:51 a.m.
