Vice Chairman McIntyre called the meeting to order at 8:21 a.m.

Vice Chairman McIntyre presented a request for approval of a Budget Resolution Amending the McLean County Fiscal Year 2012 Combined Annual Appropriation and Budget Ordinance, Fund 0160 MDT, Court Services Department 0022 – Court Services.

Ms. Lori McCormick, Director, Court Services, explained that the Court Services Department had previously been notified that the MDT Grant funded through the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority allowed for the modification of the Grant Coordinator position from 1 FTE to .5 FTE. Ms. McCormick advised that the additional money is being transferred into the training budget.

She noted that this was all approved other than the salary moving in January of this year.
