Chairman Rackauskas presented a request for approval of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Bloomington, IL and the County of McLean, IL, 2012 Byrne Justice Assistant Grant (JAG) Program Award – Sheriff's Department.

Sheriff Emery explained that the County does not receive any of these funds nor does it have any obligation under this Agreement other than acknowledging awareness of this Memorandum of Understanding. He added that the funds do not go through the County.

Chairman Rackauskas asked how these funds will be used. Sheriff Emery replied that Bloomington and Normal will use these funds to purchase equipment.
