
Chairman Caisley called the meeting to order at 8:50 a.m. He presented for action a request to approve a contract between Advanced Correctional Healthcare and McLean County for Physician Services at the McLean County Adult Detention Facility and Juvenile Detention Center through the Sheriff's Office. Ms. Schafer asked how much more this contract was for. Mr. Wasson stated that it would be approximately \$10,000 more per year. Mr. Wasson explained that Staff reached out to others but proposals could not be successfully developed. He stated that this company does business across the Midwest and they will bring experience in providing medical treatment to individuals in correctional facilities that others would not have been able to. He said that they can also provide insight to us as we design the new facility. Chairman Caisley asked if other Counties were using this company. Mr. Sandage confirmed there were other Counties and that they had interviewed them. Mr. Wasson reminded the committee that St. Joseph extended the contract for 60 days to the end of February so we really need a contract in place by March 1<sup>st</sup>.

Motion by Schafer/Rankin to Recommend Approval a contract between Advanced Correctional Healthcare and McLean County for Physician Services at the McLean County Adult Detention Facility and Juvenile Detention Center through the Sheriff's Office.

Motion carried.

There being nothing further to come before the Committee at this time, Chairman Caisley adjourned the meeting at 8:55 a.m.
