ISU Stevenson Center Data Report

Derek Conley presented two different tables regarding the average daily jail population (the first 151 days of the year, inmates per day) and a table comparing the daily jail population to past years (2014 and 2015). There is a trend of increasing jail population in 2016, this mirrors 2014, but is the reverse of 2015. Thus, no definitive conclusions can be made about the outcome of 2016 in terms of trends in jail population.

By the end of June 2016, the ISU Stevenson Center will begin analysis of the impact of the pre-trial assessment project on the jail population. Additionally, the effect of charge severity and average daily population trends will be available.

There was a short discussion of misdemeanor cases in custody. The State's Attorney's office will review all CM cases in custody.

There was a suggestion for analysis of the total number of bookings in relation to jail population over time (is one correlated with the other?). The ISU Stevenson Center will add that to the analysis.

Meeting with the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority

There will be a meeting with the IJCIA on **June 30, 2016 beginning at 11:00 a.m.** in RM 702 of the Law & Justice Center. Lunch will be provided. The ISU Stevenson Center will present their on-going analysis of jail population trends.

Expansion/Remodeling of the McLean County Jail

The architects gave a preliminary report to the Public Building Commission on June 7, with a follow-up meeting later today (6/8) with the jail staff and County Administrator to discuss some modifications. A representative from the Farnsworth Group will give a presentation on the redesign at the July 13 CJCC meeting.

Pre-Trial Assessment Pilot (PSA)

Lori McCormick gave an overview of the PSA pilot (from January 11 – June 7):

- Over 1000 PSA reports have been produced
- 260 Bond Reports written

- 151 persons are on pre-trial supervision
- 50 persons have been discharged from pre-trial supervision
- Of the 50, 15 failed to complete pre-trial supervision (6 FTA, 9 new offenses)

There will be a review of the correlation between the PSA scores of the 50 discharged persons. The Arnold Foundation is coming for a 6-month review later this month.

DUI Disposition Standards

Judge Freitag will be convening a group to determine an appropriate disposition standard of DUI cases. He will report by September on those efforts.
