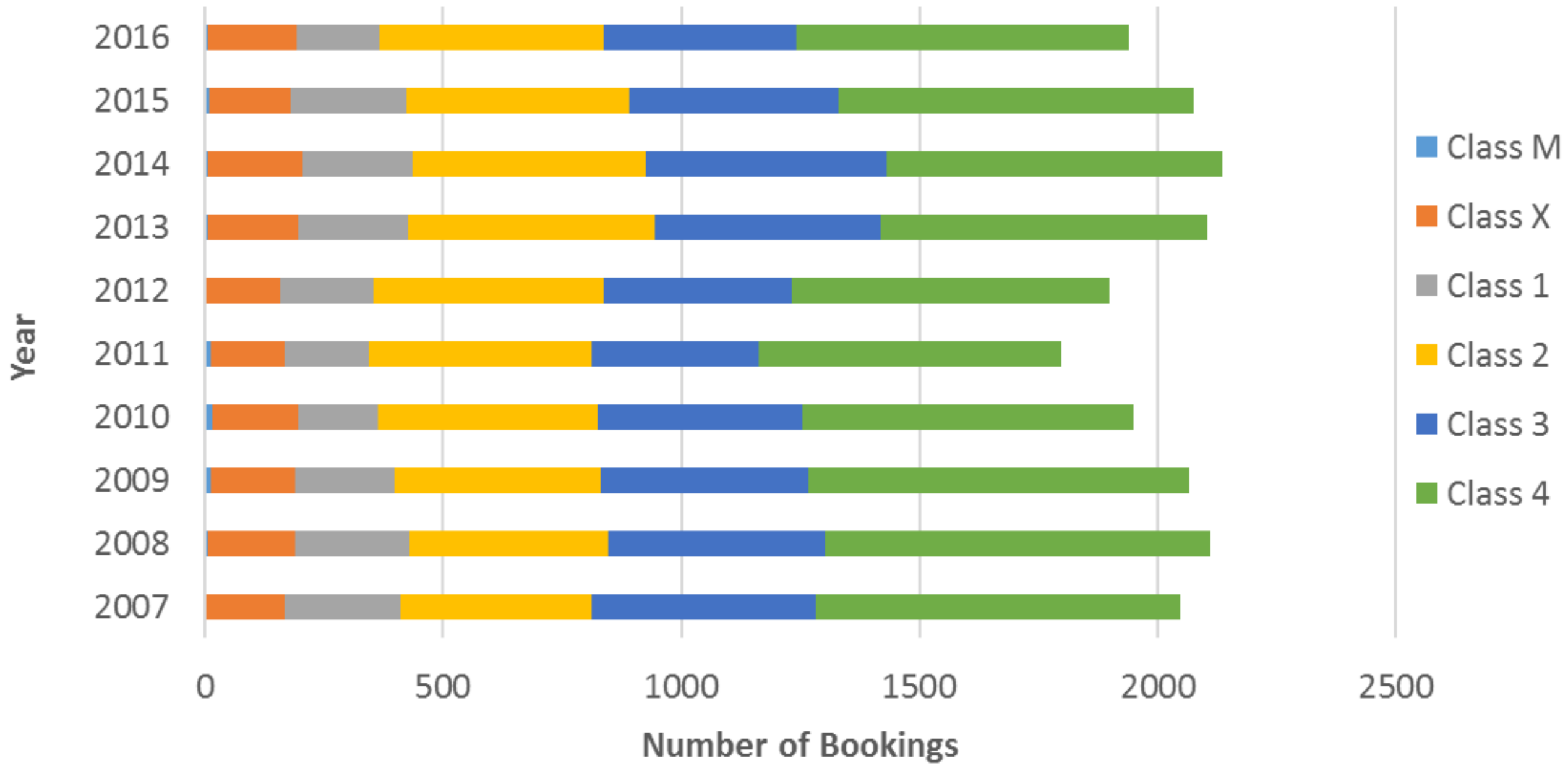

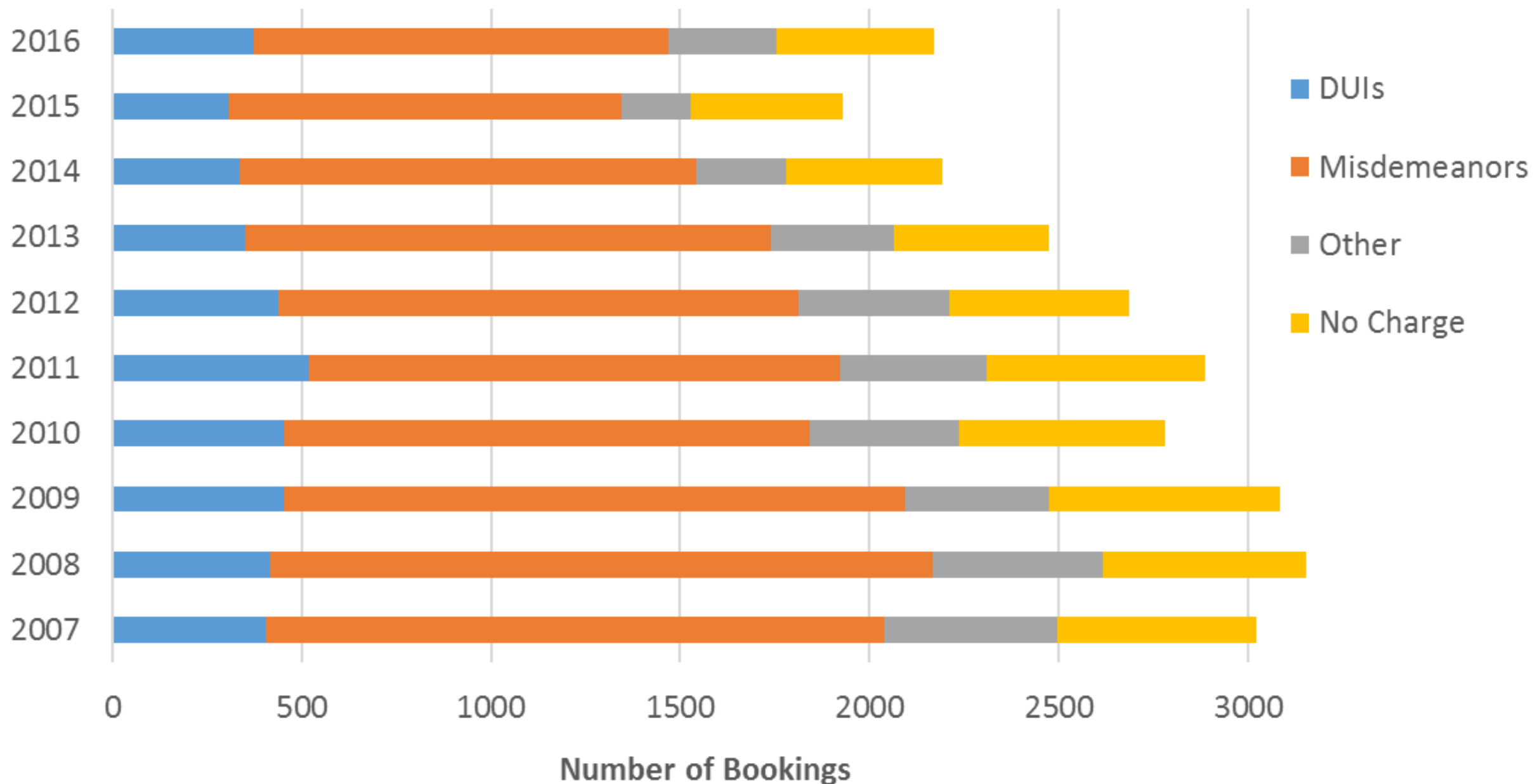

2007-2016

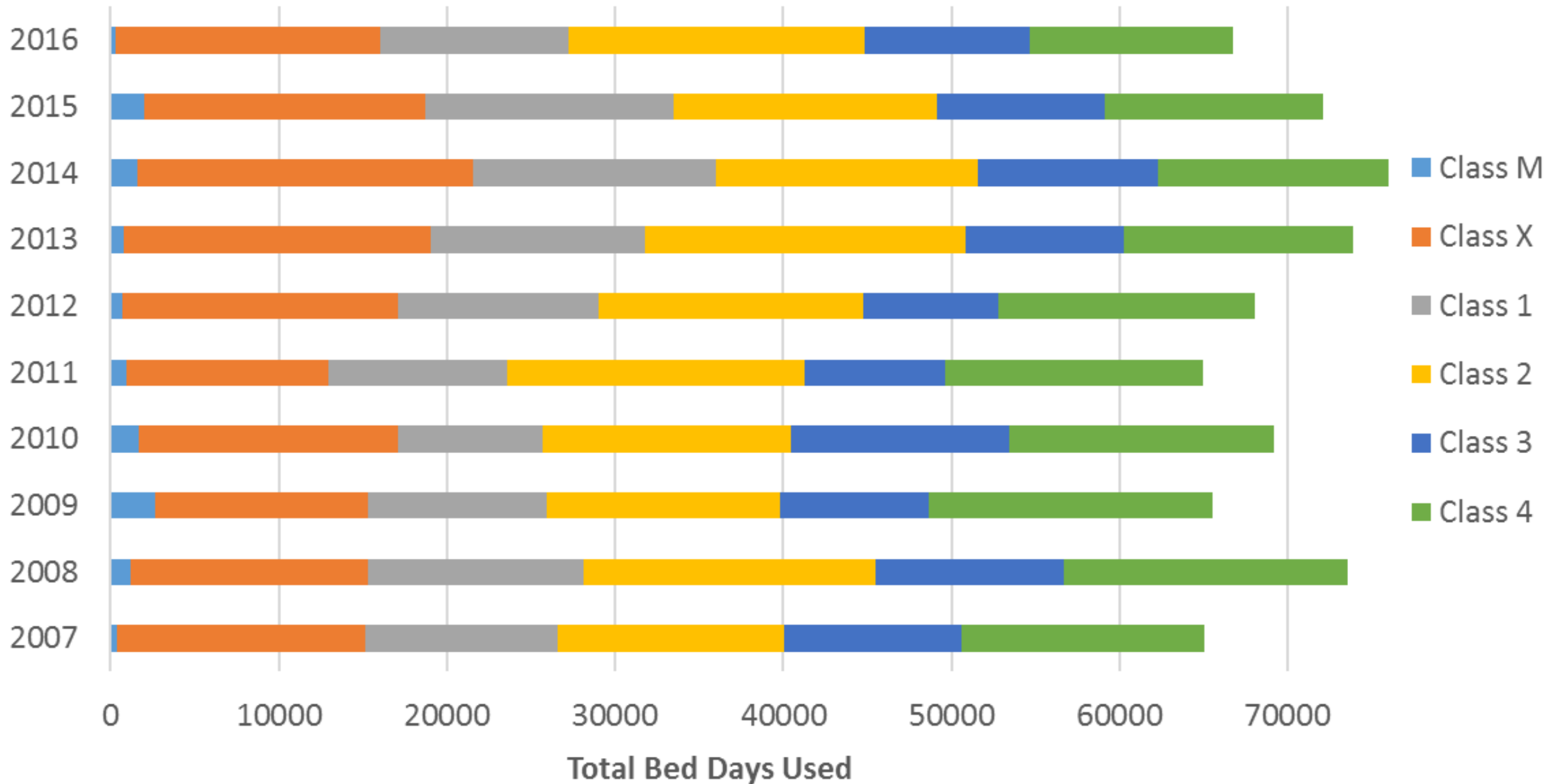
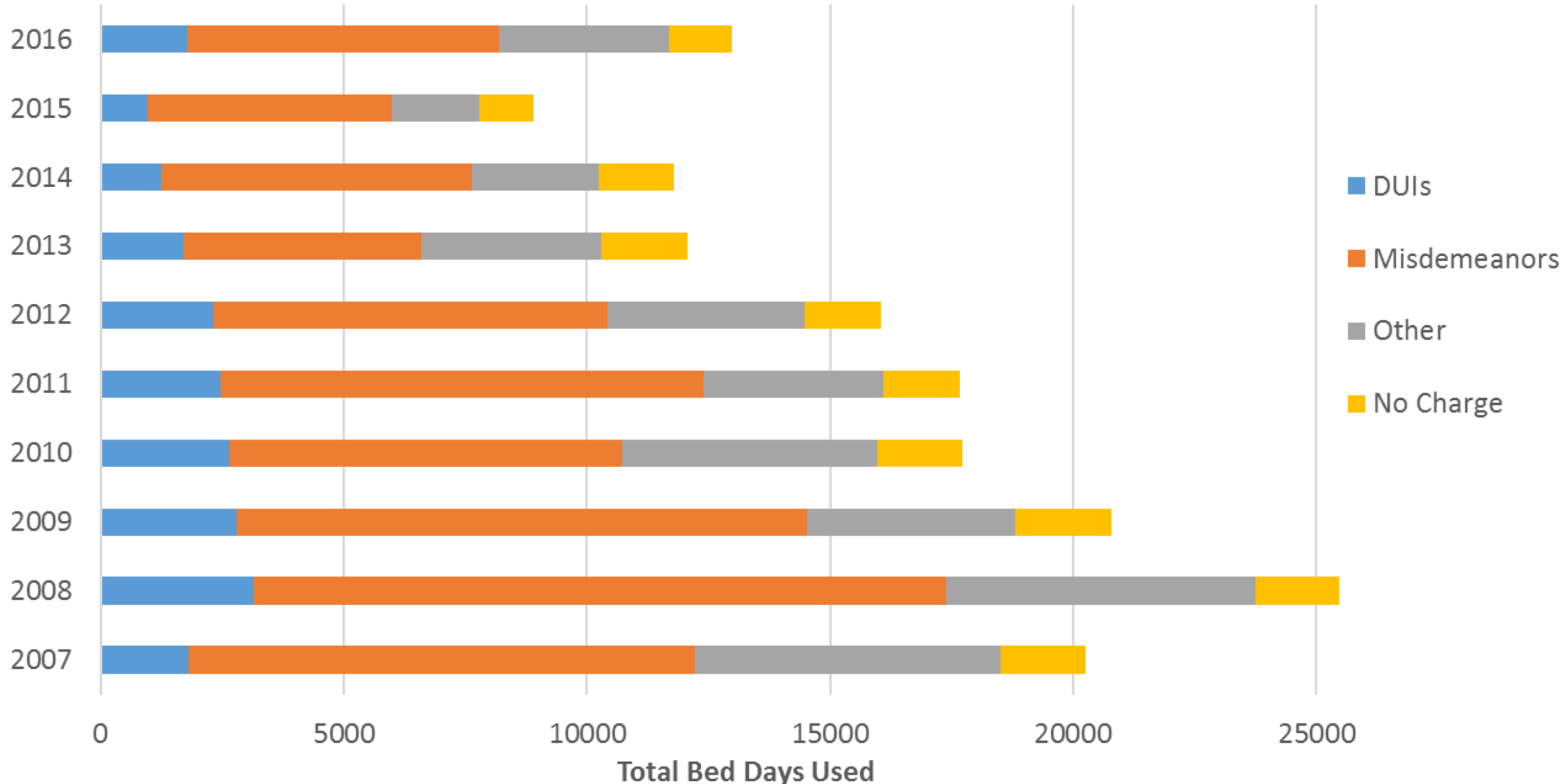
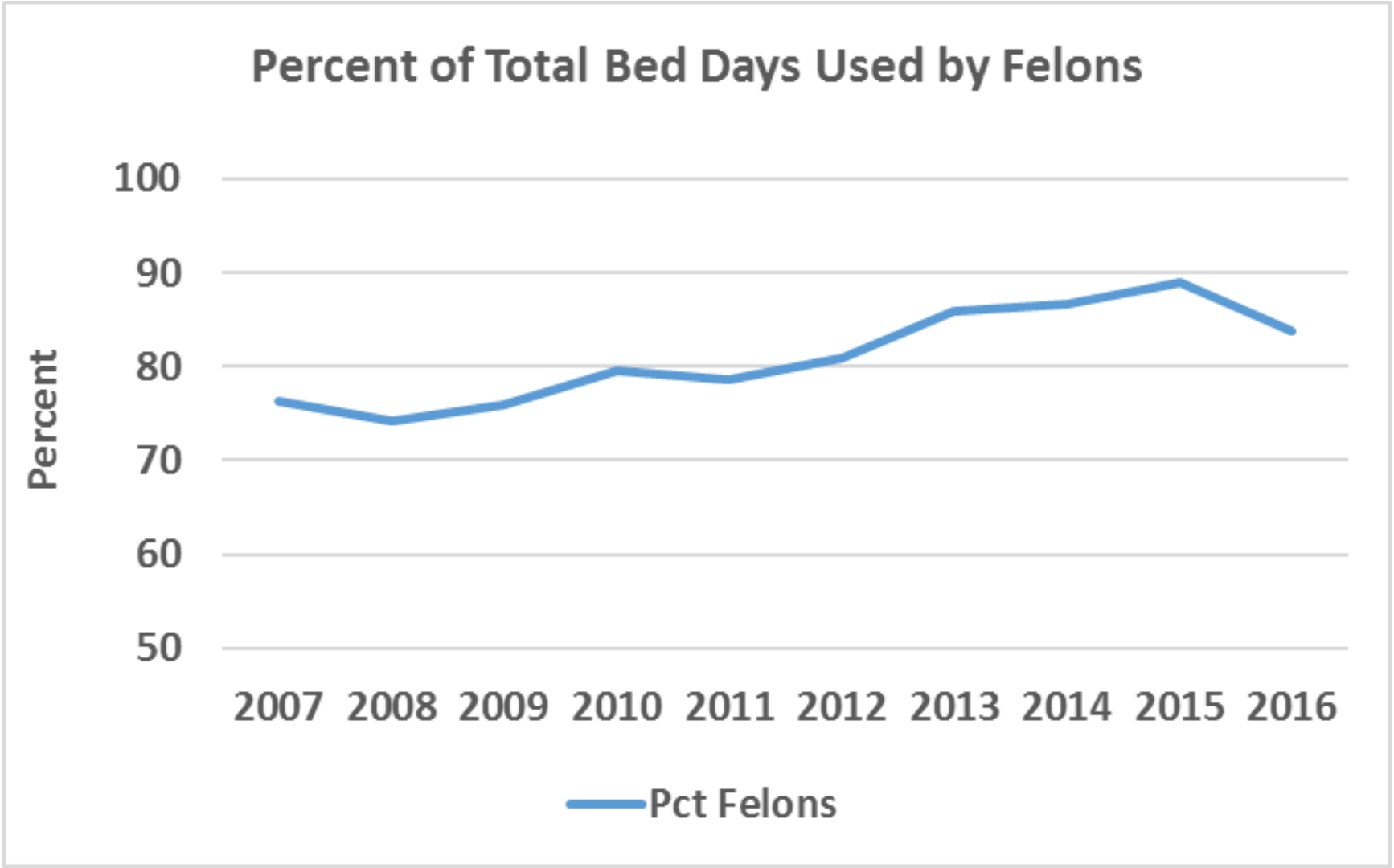


Chart 3b. Total Bed Days Used by Charge Severity (Lesser Charges),

- Analyze the impact of Public Safety Assessments on length of stay in the jail for misdemeanants.
