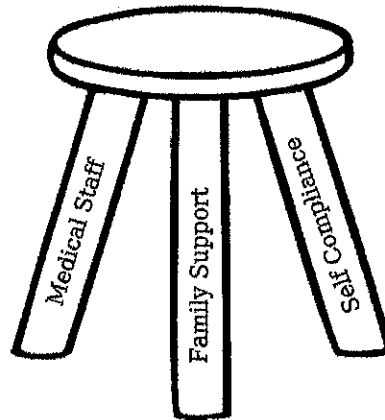


Closing the Gap Project
